in Bonn | Germany**

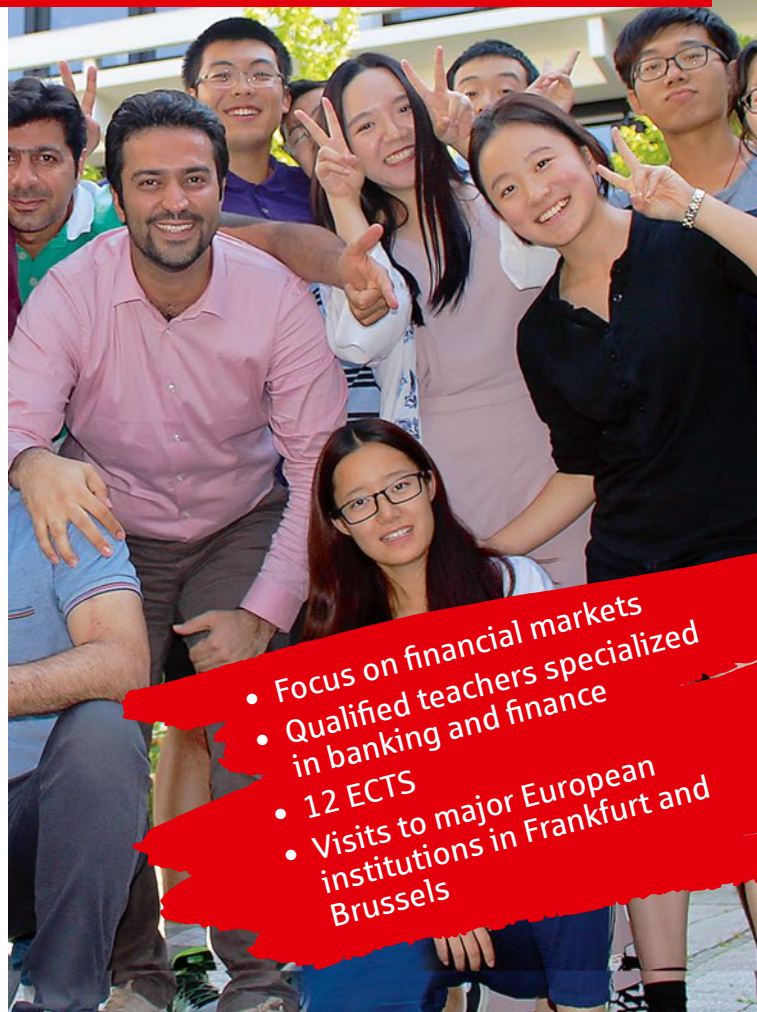

Our program in detail

The Summer School Finance 2018 is designed for students and young professionals worldwide with a strong interest in European and international financial markets, economics and business administration. This program provides an overview of the European monetary and financial system as well as insight into international banking in Europe generally and Germany specifically. It is a great opportunity to get a first-hand look at banking.

It is also an excellent way to improve your business English, specifically in financial services and banking regulation. The English Course is taught by a native speaker.

Additional highlights include a visit to the European Parliament in Brussels and the German Central Bank in Frankfurt. A business simulation will strengthen your professional, practical, and soft skills.

The program runs just over five weeks and takes place from 25 July to 31 August 2018. Each week is dedicated to a special topic. You can also register for a single week if you want to focus on a particular topic.

- ✓ European Banking Regulation, International Markets, Excursion to Frankfurt (3 ECTS) | 13-18 August 2018 | fee: €1,200
- ✓ Business Administration, Management and Leadership (3 ECTS) | 20–24 August 2018 | fee: €1,000
- ✓ Strategic Business Simulation (Bank Management Game) | 27–31 August 2018 | fee: €1,000

- ✓ improve their spoken and written English, especially business English for financial services and banking regulation
- ✓ understand financial instruments and markets
- ✓ gain insight into the European market and banking system
