Weekly topics

14 July – 19 July 2025: Intercultural Management, Excursion to Frankfurt (3 ECTS) | fee: €1000

21 July – 26 July 2025: International Management, Excursion to Brussels (3 ECTS) | fee: €1000

Students will

- · learn about intercultural management skills,
- improve communication skills in an international business environment,
- gain an overview of different management skills in business administration and economics with an international focus,
- understand the main principles of international economics,
- learn about international trade and international capital markets from the perspective of the European Union,
- · develop critical reasoning skills, and
- improve organizational and personal skills.
